



This summer will more than **40.000 scouts** and guides from the whole world participate in the biggest [Jamboree in the Nordic countries](#). It takes place the **23rd-31st of July in Denmark, near Copenhagen**, and is organized by five Danish Scout and Guides associations and more than 4.000 volunteers who create more than 200 fun and educational activities under its theme 'Our common future'.

During the Jamboree you will be able to act as an environmental journalist. You will interview Jamboree participants, take photos, and create videos that focus on environmental issues, such as litter and waste, climate change and loss of biodiversity. You will disseminate your stories through various media channels (Facebook, Instagram, various websites) and help raise public awareness about environmental challenges. At the end of the Jamboree, you will get a certificate from the YRE international programme!

[Young Reporters for the Environment](#) (YRE) is one of the five programmes running by Foundation for Environmental Education (FEE). **FEE is the world's largest environmental education organization**, active in over 100 countries around the world. Its YRE programme aims to **empower young people aged 11-25** to take an educated stand on environmental issues they feel strongly about and to give them a platform to articulate these issues through the media of writing, photography, and video.

- Share useful resources already available on the YRE website. Feel free to already take a look!



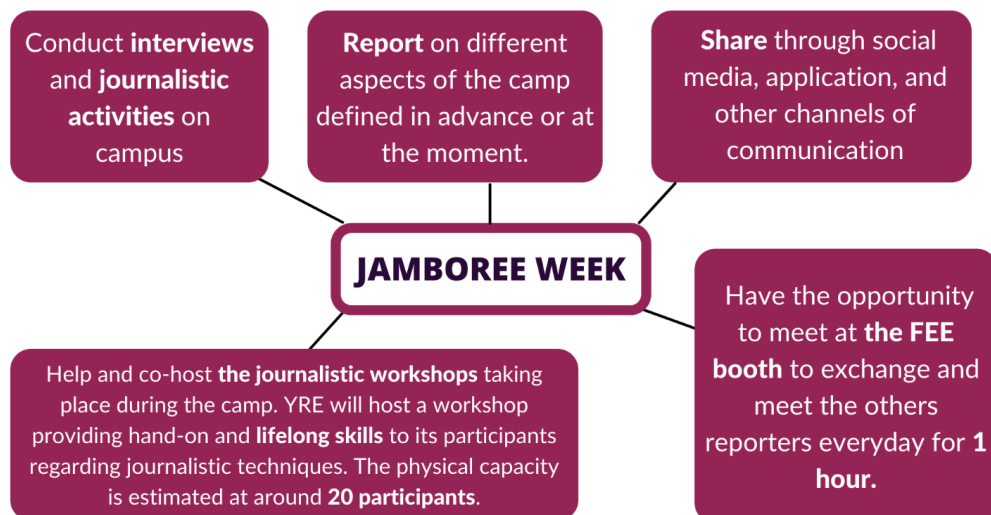
Optional: Take part in [FEE Academy courses](#) ! about how to use photography for environmental journalism, how to develop a strategy to implant circular economy
